



Gift packets

Time needed: 15 minutes | Age: 5 or over

Difficulty: ★★☆☆

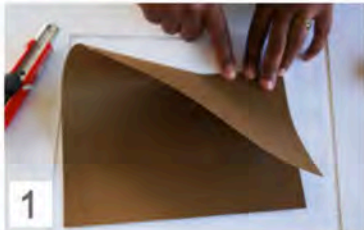


Material

- [Starry origami sheets](#)
- [Polkadot origami sheets](#)
- [Sheets of Bristol card](#)
- [Decorative sticky tape](#)
- [Balls of matt-finish embroidery thread](#)
- [Bottle of Twist and Glue](#)
- Scissors

Steps

1. Fold a sheet of Bristol card in half and cut along the fold.
2. Take one of the half-sheets and do the same again.
3. Apply decorative sticky tape to one edge on one side of the sheet, which becomes the outside
4. Carefully bend the sheet to bring the edges together, then attach one to the other with the tape.
5. Fold the ends over until they meet.
6. Fasten the packet closed with embroidery thread or coloured raffia.





Gift bag

Time needed: 15 minutes | Age: 4 or over

Difficulty: ★☆☆



Material

- [White paper carrier bags for decorating yourself.](#)
- [Decorative sticky tape](#)
- [Reel of matt-finish ribbon](#)
- Pencil
- Scissors

Steps

1. Trace the shape or the message you want to add onto the white carrier bag.
2. Cut pieces of decorative tape and stick them in place to make the shape you want according to your inspiration.
 - + You can make a custom bag and adapt all the Christmas shapes as your imagination takes you
