




# Origami Fish

Time needed: 45 minutes

Difficulty: ★★☆☆

Age: 6 or over




## Material

- Satin cord
- Sheets of origami paper
- Eye stickers
- Pom-poms


## Steps

### The fish


1. Cut 15cm squares out of the origami sheets, one square for each fish you want.
2. Fold the model following the photographs. You can mark out the vertical, horizontal, and diagonal folds on the back of the paper to use as a guide.
3. Make the initial folds.




4. Turn the paper right side up and bring one of the corners to the centre. Turn the sheet back over and fold the edges toward the centre.




5. Make the top and bottom folds then make the diagonal folds towards the left and right.




6. Lift the top while pulling the two corners of the paper outward, then flatten.



7. Lift the two points near the top then flatten.




8. Fold the fishtail in two.



9. To shape the second fin, bring the bottom part toward the top, pulling the point outward, then flatten.

10. Attach the eye stickers.



#### The ribbon

1. Thread the cord through the folds of the fish, make a knot, thread on a pom-pom, then make another knot.
2. Repeat for each fish and each pom-pom.
