

| EASTER WREATH



8 years + | Difficulty: ★★ | 1 hour 30

You need:

- Polystyrene wreath to decorate
- Polystyrene eggs to decorate
- Mini glue gun
- Pink patterned paper
- Permanent marker with wide conical tip (green)
- Plants patterned paper
- Natural raffia
- Sisal wool (green)
- And also:



Steps :

- Wrap the raffia all around the wreath to hide the polystyrene.
- Make 2 differently sized origami chickens (10-cm square and 15-cm square).
- Glue the chickens onto the wreath using the glue gun (step to be done by an adult).
- Colour in the polystyrene egg with the green marker.
- Cut out the rabbit motif from the patterned paper and glue it to the egg.
- Form a nest with the sisal wool.
- Glue the nest onto the egg (step to be done by an adult).
- Glue the egg onto the wreath (step to be done by an adult).
- Tie a piece of raffia around the wreath to hang it up.
- Your wreath is ready to be hung on the door!
