



Twine eggs

Time needed: 45 minutes

Difficulty: ★★☆☆



Material

- Balloons
- Twine
- Glue
- Paintbrush

Steps

1. First blow up the balloons to the size of the finished eggs.
2. Apply glue to each balloon with the paintbrush.
3. Place some glue in a pot or bowl then dip the twine in.
4. Wind the twine around the neck of the balloon then gradually around the whole of the balloon.
5. Leave the glued twine to dry for five hours.
6. Burst the balloon with a pin and carefully detach the remaining pieces, leaving the rigid twine.
7. Pass a cord through the eggs to make a festoon.
